The purpose of the dress code is to ensure that reasonable and appropriate standards are maintained at all times while on Club premises, in keeping with the expectations of membership at a private club.

<b>Clubhouse</b>	Smart Casual
	Smart after 6pm
<b>Coral Dining Room &amp; Longtail Terrace</b>	Smart Casual before 6pm
	Smart after 6pm. Sunday Family night Smart Casual.
<b>Beach Terrace</b>	Casual including Swimwear
<b>Beach</b>	Smart Casual after 6pm
	Appropriate swimwear
<b>Tennis Courts</b>	Casual
	White regulation tennis attire at all times.
<b>Gym</b>	Athletic Attire

Attire	Description
<b>Casual</b>	Men: Shorts or Swim Shorts, polo style shirt, tennis shoes and flip flops acceptable.
	Women: Swimwear with shorts, blouse, top, sun dress or other appropriate cover. Sandals and flip flops.
	Children: Shorts, tee shirts, appropriate logos. Flip Flops.
<b>Smart Casual</b>	Men: Slacks, Bermuda shorts, collared shirt or sweater. Turtle neck permitted. No flip flops.
	Women: Slacks, blouse, skirts, sweater, dress. Appropriate footwear, no flip flops.
	Children: Slacks, smart shorts with belts, collared shirt for boys. Pants, smart shorts, skirts or dresses for girls. No flip flops.
<b>Smart</b>	Men: Sports jacket with slacks, Bermuda shorts with long socks, collared shirt, tucked in. Tie is optional. Appropriate dress shoes.
	Women: Business suits or tailored pants, skirts and dresses. Appropriate dress shoes.
	Children: Slacks and collared shirt for boys. Pants, skirts or dresses for girls. Appropriate dress shoes.
<b>Athletic</b>	Clean and tasteful workout clothes and shoes appropriate to your activities. Non marking shoes in Squash Courts. Shirtless attire only on the beach.
<b>Swimwear (Ages two and older)</b>	Appropriate swimwear bottoms for men and boys. Top and bottom for women and girls, one or two piece acceptable. Footwear must be worn when leaving the beach area. Shoes and cover up required to enter the Clubhouse. Swimwear only not permitted in the main Clubhouse and certain designated enclosed lounge, cocktail and dining areas.
